

## **Portfolio: Glynn Grylls**

Glynn has lived in Maidenhead for over 40 years and been a keen photographer during all of that time.

In his youth he was regularly found in his grandfather's darkroom, before turning exclusively to transparencies or "slides". Since the late 1990s he has concentrated on the digital image – not really a surprise, as he's a graphic designer.

His photographs are recognisable by their strong sense of graphic design, controlled use of colour and clear concentration on the subject matter. He often deploys subtle editing techniques to sharpen objects or blur areas, ensuring that the viewer's attention is not deflected from the core elements of the photograph.

The series of prints in this small exhibition all feature wild creatures, but his dominant aim through his photographic career has been to capture the landscape. Amongst many other destinations his interest has taken him to Iceland, South America, Alaska and the Galapagos Islands.

Glynn was chairman of Maidenhead Camera Club during the 1990s.

Maidenhead Camera Club is a friendly group of around seventy people. We meet at 19.45 on Tuesday evenings at Cox Green Community Centre, from early September to May. The emphasis is on learning and encouraging each other, and we welcome everyone whether they're a beginner or an expert. Come along to a few meetings (there's no cost) and see for yourself!
